General Rules:

- All rulings will be made by the executive committee. All rulings will be final.
 - Committee members: Greg Floyd, Troy Bogard, Adam Zimmerman, Marc Townsend and Colby Foster
- You must fish 6 tournaments to qualify for classic.
- Short fish is loss of fish.
- 1 lb. deduction for every dead fish.
- 1 lb. deduction for every 5 minutes late.
- If late to start, find member and pay before you start fishing.
- Payouts will be as follow:
- 1 4 boats pay 1^{st} place only = 100%
- 5 9 boats pay 1st and 2nd place = 60%, 40%

10+ boats pay 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} place = 50%, 30%, 20%

- General safety rules apply---Life jackets, no alcohol etc.
- General bass tournaments rules apply: No trolling, no live bait, etc.
- Split pot on all ties.
- **Six-hour tournaments**---Starting at good light. First 2 Tournaments start 9am. Classic 8 hours.
- 5 fish limits (Black Bass)—12" minimum length limit or AG&F rules.
- Club fee = \$50 each Money to go toward classic and Anglers of the year.
- Entry fee = \$60 Boat \$10 will go toward Big Bass

Anglers of the Year Rules:

- 40% from membership club fees will go to the top 2 winning teams (60, 40)
- Place Points will be based on your best 8 tournaments fished.
 - Weights of all 10 Tournaments will be applied to AOY.
- Points will be awarded based on Tournament place (max 8 Tournaments) and LBS caught (all Tournaments fished, Max 10).
- AOY points will be applied if fished:
 - With regular partner.
 - Alternate
 - Alternate must pay \$50 Club dues
 - Each member gets 1 alternate
 - Any kid 18 years old or less.
