SEE FOLLOWING RULES & REGULATIONS ON BACK

1. **Rules:** The following rules for this tournament will be used. The rules will be interpreted by the Tournament Officials, and all decisions are final. All participants will abide by all federal, state, and local regulations.
2. **Eligibility:** Only individuals 18 years of age or older are eligible to participate unless participating with a consenting parent or legal guardian, and who have paid the proper entry fees. **Participants 16 or 17 years of age competing without an adult must have their parent send confirmation email corey.ruff@cps.k12.ar.us prior to entering, have parent signature on the entry form and show Boaters Ed. Card at Registration.**
3. Entry form must be filled out and signed by both contestants.
4. **Entry Fees:** \$125 per boat.(**2 Person Team**)
5. **Team definition:** No more than 2 participants per boat. It is understood that high school fishing teams have a boat captain but for this tournament the committee chose to leave the rules as stated. Only 2 participants in the boat. **No third person.**
6. **Take-off:** Order of take-off will be determined by order registrations are received. For example, the first team to register will be first to take off, the last to register will be last to take off. Participants will be given a small wooden paddle or numbered poker chip at the check-in site before the tournament begins with a number on it showing their number for take-off. The take-off site will be the official check-in site for the tournament. Live wells and safety devices will be checked before take-off. No boat will leave until instructed to do so. This is a point of immediate disqualification.
7. **Prizes:** \$2000 guaranteed to 1st Place with a minimum of 50 boats entered. One place will be paid out for every 8 boats entered.
8. **Permitted Fishing Locations:** No fishing or culling inside the buoys of Devils Fork Ramp.
9. **Boat & Motors:** All boats must meet U.S. Coast Guard and State water patrol regulations. Horsepower may not exceed the manufacturer's rating for that boat. No overpowered motors.
10. **Safety & Sportsmanship:** Safe boating and fishing practices must be observed at all times. Life jacket laws must be followed. Each contestant is expected to follow the highest standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, safety and conservation. At the discretion of the Tournament Director, the tournament may be shortened or cancelled due to unsafe weather or water conditions. Any boat or participant may be checked at any time for any reason. Absolutely no alcohol or illegal drugs may be used during tournament hours. Anyone suspected of using or being impaired by alcohol or illegal drugs, immediately before or during tournament hours, will be disqualified.
11. **Fish: 5 Fish Limit** consisting of only Largemouth, Smallmouth, and Spotted Bass. Largemouth, Smallmouth, and Spotted Bass must be at least **12** Inches. Tournament Officials will measure all fish with a "Gator Grip Golden Rule Board" (mouth closed and tail pinched.) **Dead Fish Penalty:** No more than **2** dead fish may be weighed resulting in a **8oz** penalty per fish. Attempting to weigh **3** or more dead fish will result in disqualification.
12. **Check-in:** Boats must be inside the buoys off pad by designated check-in time. Contestants who are not at the check-in area at the appointed time will be penalized 1 pound per minute, deducted from the total weight, including any weight to be counted toward the Big Bass Award. Any contestant more than 15 minutes late will lose credit for that day's weight. Contestants must present your paddle
13. **Closing of Scales:** Scales will close 30 minutes after the final flight is due in. Any change to the above stated official scale closing time will be announced during registration, during the morning boat check, or during weigh-in. It is the angler's responsibility to verify the official scale closing time and to be in the weigh-in line by such time.
